

Diana Harlick is the lead manager at the San Mateo County Office of Education (SMCOE) for The Big Lift - a countywide collective impact initiative to increase the percentage of children reading proficiently at third grade. In this role, she works with major funders, county leadership, school district leadership, and preschool leadership to improve the quality and alignment of preschool-to-third grade (P-3) education and community programs. This includes developing and managing a \$1 million annual project budget and a staff of 3 people plus ~20 subcontractors/consultants to implement P-3 quality supports, data management and evaluation. She oversees the design and implementation of The Big Lift external evaluation in partnership with the RAND Corporation and the Silicon Valley Community Foundation.

Diana has held leadership, program management, and research positions in state and local government (California Department of Education; First 5 San Mateo) as well as in statewide and local nonprofits. Over the course of her career, Diana has designed and executed community initiatives from start-up to completion, monitored portfolios of grantees, and designed and implemented several comprehensive evaluation strategies and studies. Diana has a B.A. in Sociology and French from the University of California, Davis and a Master's degree in Public Administration with an emphasis in policy analysis.
